Moreover a professional dimension will be added to the meeting with the presence of Mr Olivier Bonnin (Deputy CEO of Bouygues Construction) who will talk about PhD Students' opportunities in the private sector.

Submission Process:

Submitted abstracts should include the following information:

- The title of the paper
- Name(s) of Author(s) with the name of the person presenting the paper
- Institutional affiliation of the author(s), with complete e-mail of the presenter
- Keywords (max 5)
- Abstract of the paper no longer than 2 pages and 1 page for the references
- File format: .doc, .docx, .pdf.

Submission of abstracts should be sent via e-mail to adam.ecogestion@yahoo.fr with « submission » written on the object of the e-mail before **March 28, 2011**. Acceptance or refusal will be notified on **April 15, 2011**. Final papers should be submitted by **May 23, 2011**. Final papers can be sent either in English or in French, but presentations will be conducted in English.

Fees: 40€ before **May 23, 2011**, including catering costs for lunch and dinner.
